



Jewish Content Coaching

An opportunity for you to gain insight and learn from a scholar who can help you find, learn, and implement Jewish texts and ideas into your programs and educational approach

What is the structure and who is involved?

After you fill out a quick intake form, you will be matched with a scholar from the Pardes Institute of Jewish Studies who will conduct a short intake conversation to define the goals. After that, you will have a one-off session with a scholar from the Pardes.

What are possible outcomes from Jewish Content Coaching?

- Infuse your programs with relevant Jewish ideas
- Instill a sense of confidence around incorporating Jewish text
- Enhance the depth of Jewish content you bring to your work
- Broaden your awareness of Jewish values and texts

How does it work?

You will start by thinking about a program or topic you want help with, and put that information into the intake form. The more details you can include, the better. A few days later, a Pardes scholar will contact you, and you will arrange to talk for 15-20 minutes to explain what you are looking for, and clarify your needs. Then you will arrange a 45-60 minute zoom meeting with the Pardes scholar a few days later, at which they will bring more texts and ideas for you to learn and discuss.

In principle this is a one-time meeting for a single program. If you are interested in another meeting, on a different topic, you will need to send in another intake form.

How do I sign up?
